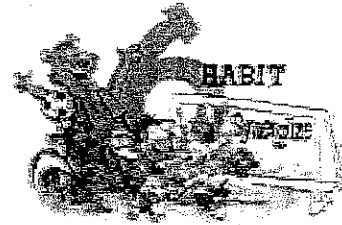

Kayla: It feels good. I really like my job!

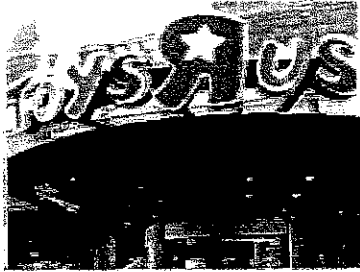

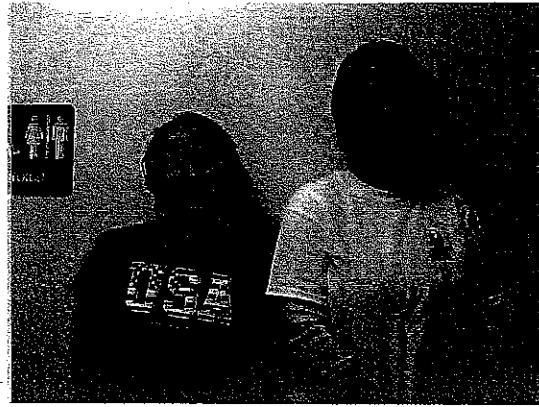
# The Stomach Virus

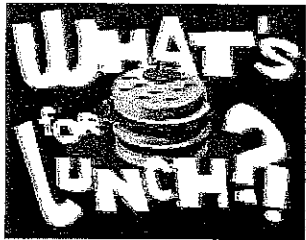
What do you think about the school basketball team?

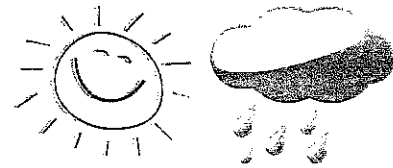
# Food Critic
