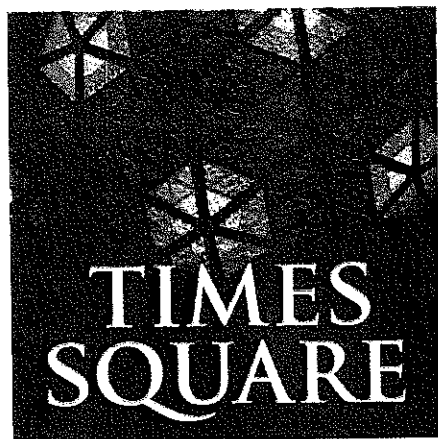

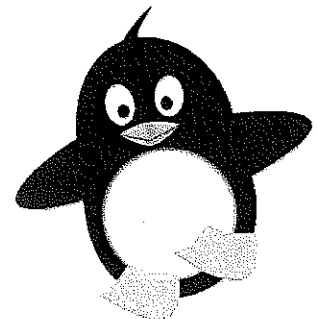
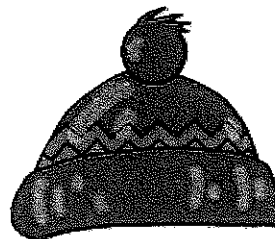
# Will's zany facts of the month

2. The coldest temperature ever recorded was on July 21, 1983 in Antarctica. It was -89 degrees Celsius.

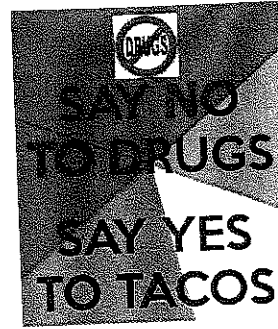
