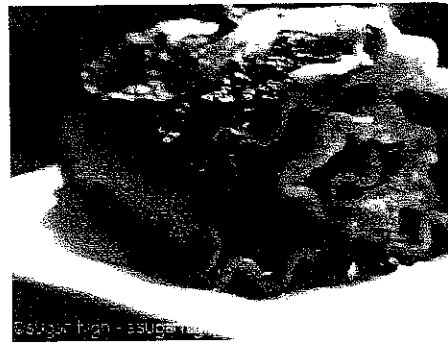


This month the food has been pretty good. The thing I remember most is lasagna. I think this is the first year we've had it too. It is probably my favorite food they've added.
