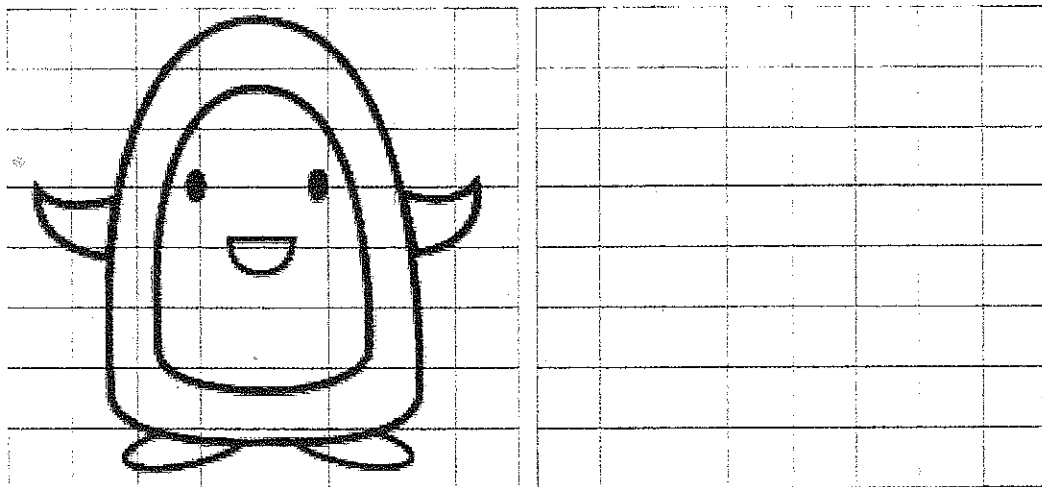


Comic strip Contest
